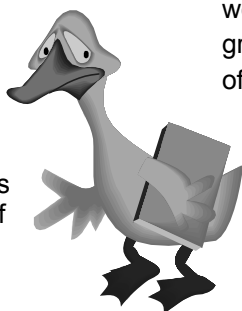
Having 8 competitors plus the Team Manager and Mechanic of a 16 member team is a great representation for the club. GO QUEENSLANDER!
