Before turning up to proficiency on any of the above dates, there are a few pre-requisites everyone must meet:

- You must be a financial member. Renew your membership for 2023/24 and process payment (https://members.sls.com.au/)

- 2. Register online to attend one of the Skills Maintenance sessions, you will need to register via the SLSA Members Area Portal (https://members.sls.com.au/). Once logged in, click on eLearning on the top menu bar, then log in to eLearning, on the left hand side click Training Event, find the date that suits you to complete your skills maintenance (13 Aug, 2 Sept, or 14 Oct) and click the link, then enrol, select all the awards that you need to complete and click enrol. You will receive an email once enrolment was successful.
- 3. **Complete Online Theory.** While in the e-learning section, on the left hand side, click on Training Library, then 2023 Skills Maintenance view courses, then enrol in the relevant course. This is added to your My Training section on the left hand side, view and complete the relevant online theory. We do not require a copy of completed certificates.
- 4. Once you've completed the above steps, you are ready to Attend Skills Maintenance practical session (commonly know as 'Proficiency'). If the above steps are not completed prior, you will be asked to complete this on the day. To avoid delays and an admin backlog, we ask you to complete these steps in advance.
