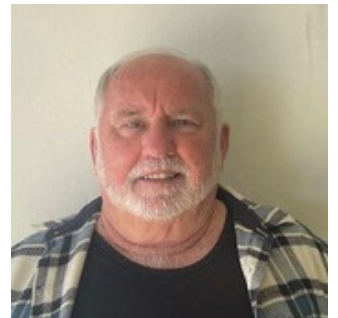

Our Nipper program is designed to nurture and develop young individuals, aged 5 to 14, into confident and capable beachgoers. Through a range of activities and training sessions, we aim to instill important life skills such as water safety, surf awareness, and teamwork. Nippers will have the opportunity to participate in exciting beach games, learn essential lifesaving techniques, and build lifelong friendships within a supportive and inclusive environment.

Step-by-Step Guide to get ready for Nippers

Now that you are a members, please see below the step-by-step guide on what needs to be achieved prior to starting nippers this season.

Step 1 - Complete Pool Preliminary Evaluation (This must be signed off before the Beach Evaluation)

- 26 August - 2pm - 4pm
- 9 September - 2pm - 4pm
- 7 October 8am - 9am

Step 2 - Complete Beach Evaluation (U8-U14 only)

- 7 October - 9:30am - 10:30am

Step 3 - Complete Competition Evaluation (U8-U14 only)

OTHER NIPPER INFO

Nippers is held on Sunday mornings. Please arrive by 8:15am and find your Age Manager to have your child signed in and ready to hit the sand by 8:30am. Nippers wraps up between 10am – 10:30am, depending on the age group and weather/surf conditions. We encourage parents to stay on the beach and actively support your child for the duration of the program. Each child must be collected by a parent/guardian at the end of each Nipper session.

Uniforms & Merchandise will be available for purchase every nipper Sunday from 7:30-9am @ North Burleigh SLSC, as well as at our Season Launch on Saturday 9th September 2023 from 8am - 9:30am

WHAT TO WEAR/BRING:

Club age cap and high visibility pink rash vest are compulsory:

U6 - Yellow

U7 - Blue

U8 - U14 - Club Caps

- Club togs & water bottle recommended
- Sunscreen and towel essential
- Goggles and Nipper board (If you have one) (U9-U14)

ON THE BEACH - WHAT HAPPENS AT NIPPERS:

Each day's activities may change depending on weather and surf conditions. Nippers will rotate through activities (water, beach, games, education)

BBQ & ROSTERING

The BBQ will sell bbq style food, drinks from 9:30am.

Each week an age group will be rostered on to assist with the BBQ, uniform, set up and pack down between 7am – 11am. The NB Nipper program is run by volunteers therefore we call upon our Nipper parents to get involved to make this all possible.

SAFETY COMES FIRST:

Each Nipper day we have 10 age groups hit the beach. This equates to over 500 nippers on the sand & in the water, plus parents, siblings & local beachgoers.



- Children must stay with their Age Manager at all times, unless coaches take over for a specific activity.
- If children must leave their group, to go to the toilet etc, the Age Manager needs to be advised by the parent.
- No child is to enter the water unless authorised by the Age Manager.
- U6 & U7s must have a parent/guardian remain with the age group at all times.
- All remaining age groups must have a parent/guardian on the beach/surrounds.
- At the conclusion of the session, children must be collected by their parent/guardian.
- Children are not to leave the Club/surrounds without an adult.

WANT TO GET INVOLVED AND HELP OUT ON NIPPER SUNDAY?

Admin, Uniform & Merch Officer x 4 - This role will consist of 4 – 6 helpers to be at the Club on Sundays from 730am – 10am to sell our uniforms and merchandise to members and the public. This will be done through the Square payment program. This role will include coordinating the Water Safety sign in/out process, handing out water safety rash vests and manages the returns of the rash vests each week.

BBQ/Food Co-Ordinator x 4 – set up starts from 8am to start serving from 10am once nippers are coming off the beach. This role requires the set up of the BBQs, eskys, ice, cook, serve, sell and pack up. The BBQS need to be cleaned and packed away any time from 11am. The BBQ coordinators will oversee and delegate to the rotating roster of age group helpers each week to assist from 9-11am.

Junior Club Photographer x 2- Get your creative juices flowing while you are at Nipper Sundays and carnivals we would love to you snap away through all the age groups and capture the fun of the members. These Images then get sent to the office for social and promotion use. Use of your own equipment is a requirement of this role. You will be acknowledged with SLSQ accreditation and will also be available as the Club photographer at surf sports carnivals. More information about the Photography Policy - [HERE](#)

Set up/Pack up Officer x 2 - From 630am, set up will begin every Sunday to set up all the flags, gazebos, BBQ, Uniform pop up, etc. Then pack up will commence when nippers concludes, from 10am onwards. This role will have extra assistance with a rotating roster, calling on age group per week to assist with set up/pack down.

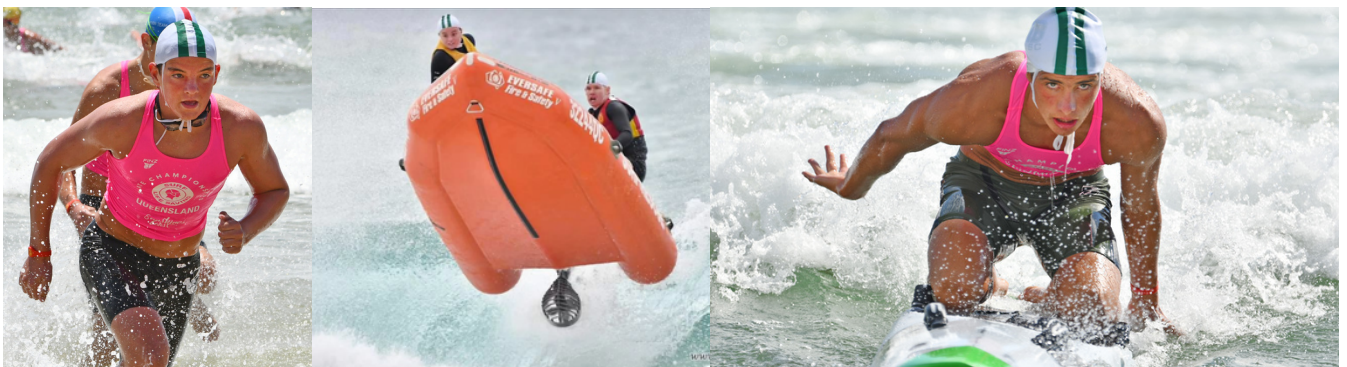

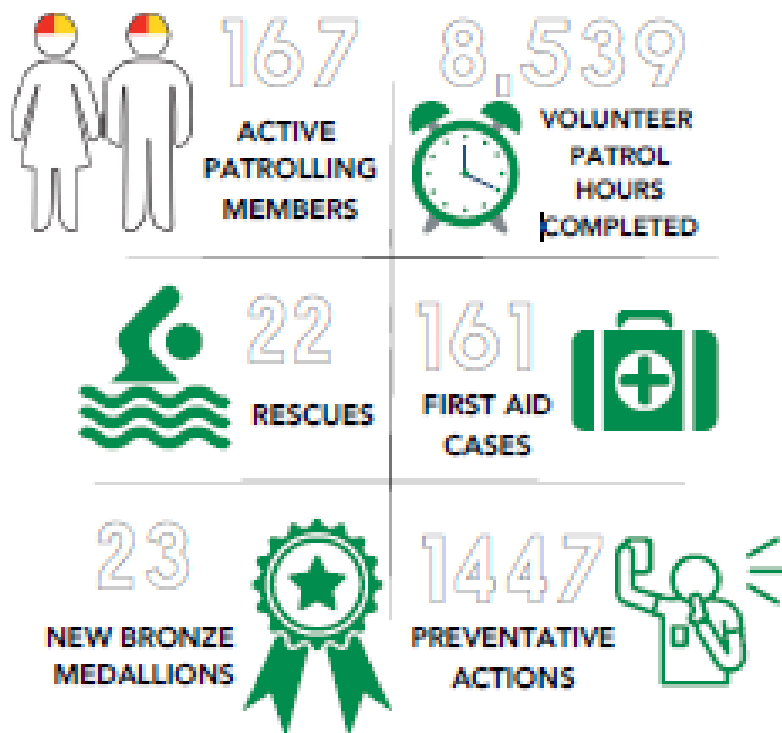
Lifesaving & Patrols

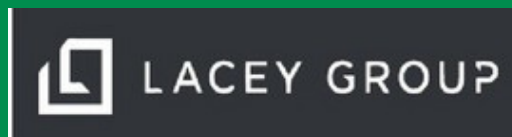
